 (Note: don't be confused by the "NSA-staff-only" exit from 295 that you pass before you get to Rt 193 you do NOT want the take that NSA exit.)
- -At the first traffic light, make a left onto Southway.
- -Make another left at the next light onto Greenbelt Road.
- -Follow Greenbelt Road for approximately 1.8 mile
- -Turn left at the light into ICESat Rd.
- -Turn left at first opportunity into Goddard Space Flight Center's VISITOR CENTER (clearly marked signs direct your turns; the Visitor Center is outside the Security Gate).

Park at the Center. A bus will take us as a group into Goddard's campus to Building 33. Dr. Trena Ferrell, NASA, will match your name with the list that we have given them and check your ID. At the Bldg 33 parking lot, one of the HoLLIE coordinators will meet you to direct you to Room H114.
